

COVID-19 Vaccine Equity Faith Summit & Week of Action

BACKGROUND

In the trying times of the pandemic, religious faith has been a guiding light for millions of people across the country. In fact, 28% of Americans say the pandemic has strengthened their faith, the highest number among economically developed countries. There are also strong numbers indicating that faith could be a deciding factor in getting a COVID-19 vaccine.

Majorities of most religious faiths believe that getting vaccinated is a way to live their religious faiths. Faith-based approaches to vaccine advocacy also present a strong opportunity to reach those among these communities that are still deciding to get vaccinated. Approximately 1/3 of Black Protestant and Hispanic catholics say faith based approaches would make them more likely to get vaccinated. In addition, 70% of Black Protestants and 53% of Hispanic Catholics would turn to religious leaders for advice. These numbers represent an opening to reach these people through their faith and influence their communities to get vaccinated.

Our goal will be to provide you with an information and resource hub that shares facts, guidance, and actions to take to help protect our communities.
