Out of this community need, My Little Taste Buds was born, and the inaugural class was held in July of 2019. Since its inception, My Little Taste Buds has grown not only in participation, but we have also been able to partner with several local organizations such as AMI and Oakview where the kids learn to work in commercial kitchen spaces.

In addition to her work with My Little Taste Buds, LaPorsha has worked as an Assistant Pastry Chef at High Point University Catering, as well as catering for her home church, Divine Healing and Restoration Ministries, and also as the Head Chef at SOP Disciples of Joy Childcare. LaPorsha has also helped build community gardens for local organizations in High Point, NC, and has personally funded and catered dinner for the unhoused communities during the holiday season in the

greater Greensboro-High Point area including making sure every child receives a Christmas gift.
